## 2014

- Completed black rasp. and most of blueberry harvest w/o sig. issues
- Mostly females in some managed plantings
- Mostly males in unmanaged planting (cherries)
  - Fluke?
  - Males (smaller) more susceptible to sprays?
  - Possible higher prop. of females when sound fruit is present?
- Using Trece lure + ACV
  - Increase in no. of FF, but not proportion of SWD to other FF, or male/female SWD ratio
  - Caught AFF earlier (Aug vs. end of Sept.)

- Changing from what to spray to how to spray
  - Concentration more important?
  - Or volume?
  - What's the best adjuvant, especially considering rainy seasons?
